TEMA:	Likes & Dislikes
OBJETIVO:	To express a preference using present simple

1.- What do I know?

What have we seen so far at school? Do you remember how to use **like & don't like** to express a preference?

Do you remember other ways of saying that you like or dislike something?

2.- CONCEPTUALIZACIÓN

Since like is a verb (gustar) we often use it after the subject (sujeto) + thing/object/person, therefore:

Subject + like + thing/object/person.

E.g. I like coffee. I like dogs.

Debido a que '**like**' es un verbo, lo usamos generalmente después del sujeto + cosa/objeto/persona, entonces:

Sujeto + Like + cosa/objeto/persona.

We use the auxiliary **DO/DOES** for negative and interrogatives as this is written in Present simple.

En el inglés usamos el auxiliar '**do/does**' para oraciones negativas o preguntas ya que estamos escribiendo en **Presente simple**.

For the negative form we add **DO/DOES + NOT (Don't/Doesn't)** before like. For the interrogative form we begin with the auxiliary **Do/DOES + subject + thing/object/person?**

Para la forma negativa añadimos '**DO/DOES + NOT (don't/doesn't)** antes de '**like**'. Para la formar preguntas empezamos con el auxiliar '**DO/DOES**' + sujeto + cosa/objeto/persona?.

Look at the examples and analyse the structure. Mira los ejemplos y analiza la estructura.

Examples

Affirmative form	Negative form	Interrogative
I like chocolate.	I don't like chocolate	Do I like chocolate?
They like the zoo.	They don't like the zoo	Do they like the zoo?
We like vegetables.	We don't like vegetables	Do we like vegetables?

Remember!

Add an 's' for she, he and it. Añade una 's' para 'she, he and it'

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
She likes apples.	She doesn't like apples.	Does she like apples?
He likes the park.	He doesn't like the park.	Does he like the park?
It likes warm water.	It doesn't like warm water.	Does it like warm water?



